MSRBA Master Breeder Award Rules

The Master Breeder Award Committee shall be appointed by the President. It is to consist of five (5) members, of which three (5) shall have received the Master Breeder Award.

No more than three (3) awards to be given in one year, with no posthumous awards.

The Master Breeder Award is a plaque suitably inscribed, plus a lifetime membership card (plastic or metal).

To be eligible for the Master Breeder Award, by the Michigan State Rabbit Breeders Association, Inc., one must be:

- 1. A resident of the State of Michigan.
- 2. A member of Michigan State Rabbit Breeders Association, Inc. for ten (10) consecutive years (BOD's February 2018).
- 3. Must have raised rabbits.
- 4. No member, while on the Committee, can be eligible for this award.
- 5. Nominations must be received by January 1st. (BOD's February 2018).

Considerations for Master Breeder Award Committee:

- 1. Interest in rabbit organizations (including 4-H rabbit Projects and A.R.B.A. Youth Programs).
- 2. Support of rabbit projects (shows, etc.)
- 3. Cooperation with fellow rabbit breeders.
- 4. Amount and quality of rabbits raised.
- 5. Any other consideration they might choose to consider.
- 6. The Committee may one (1) Honorary Master Breeder Award.
