Michigan State Rabbit Breeders Association Scholarship Due Date: January 31, 2025

Requirements:

- Applicant must be a high school senior or older, with an upper age limit of 21.
- Applicant must submit transcripts from their current educational institution (High school or otherwise).
- Applicant must show acceptance and enrollment in any type of post-high school educational institution a check will not be received until enrollment is confirmed.
- Applicant must have had a minimum of three years of consecutive MSRBA or MSRBYA membership at the time of application.

APPLICATION PROCESS:

- Member must fill out the MSRBA Scholarship application, which must be emailed to **msrbascholarship@gmail.com** by January 31, 2025.
- The application must include a short (1 typed page) essay detailing applicant's career goals and future plans.
- Application must be accompanied by a copy of the applicant's transcripts.
- Application must be accompanied by two letters of recommendation, at least one must be from a mentor in the rabbit hobby.
- Winner(s) will be announced at the MSRBA Spring Convention Banquet.

DETAILS:

- One or two scholarships, of a minimum amount of \$1,000 each year will be awarded.
- The committee has the right to award either one or two scholarships based on the quality of the applications received.
- The scholarship will be funded by the Michigan State Rabbit Breeders Association.
- The scholarship can only be received one time, but a member may apply more than once.

SCHOLARSHIP REVIEW COMMITTEE:

The committee to review and act on all applications shall be appointed by the MSRBA president. It will consist of a chair and at least three other committee members. All members of the review committee will review and rank the applicants. Review committee members will submit their top three candidates in order and points will be assigned in correlation to rank (i.e 1st = 5pts, 2nd = 3pts, 3rd = 1pt). In the event of a tie review committee members will revote on the tied candidates. If there remains a tie the chair of the committee will break the tie with their vote.
